## **RESOLUTION NO. 24-2056**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, COUNCIL PROVIDING SUPPORT TO THE AMERICAN MUSUEUM OF THE CUBAN DIASPORA'S DEMAND THAT FORMER CUBAN PILOT GONZALEZ-PRADO BE INVESTIGATED FOR HIS INVOLVEMENT IN THE 1996 UNLAWFUL SHOOTING OF SEVERAL BROTHERS TO THE RESCUE AIRPLANES; PROVIDING FOR INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CLERK; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS,** in 1996, Brothers to the Rescue pilots, flying unarmed airplanes through the Florida Straits, were unlawfully gunned down by Cuban pilots; and

WHEREAS, Cuba's Revolutionary Airforce Colonel, Luis Raul Gonzalez-Prado, allegedly was among those pilots that committed this heinous act; and

WHEREAS, recently, Luis Raul Gonzalez-Prado has sought and obtained refuge in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the American Museum of the Cuban Diaspora has taken the lead in advocating for a full investigation into Luis Raul Gonzalez-Prado's involvement in the 1996 Brothers to the Rescue massacre; and

**WHEREAS,** the American Museum of the Cuban Diaspora is a 501c 3, that operates a museum dedicated to the memory of hundreds of thousands of Cubans that have left Cuba's oppressive, communist regime in the search for freedom; and

WHEREAS, a significant number of Town of Miami Lakes (the "Town") residents are immigrants from Cuba, many who have suffered oppression and crimes against humanity while in Cuba; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes announces its support of the American Museum of the Cuban Diaspora's efforts.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals.</u> The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.
- Section 2. Support of the American Museum of the Cuban Diaspora's Efforts to Advocate for the investigation of Luis Raul Gomez-Prado, and his involvement in the unlawful shooting of unarmed, Brothers to the Rescue airplanes flying through the Florida Straits. Mayor and Town Council formally declare their support to the American Museum of the Cuban Diaspora's advocacy in furtherance of investigating Luis Raul Gonzalez-Prado's involvement in the unlawful 1996 shooting of several Brothers to the Rescue planes flying through the Florida Straits.
- Section 3. Instructions to the Town Clerk, The Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to Congressman Mario Diaz Balart, Congressman Carlos Gimenez, Congresswoman Maria Salazar, and Homeland Security Secretary Mayorkas.
- **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
